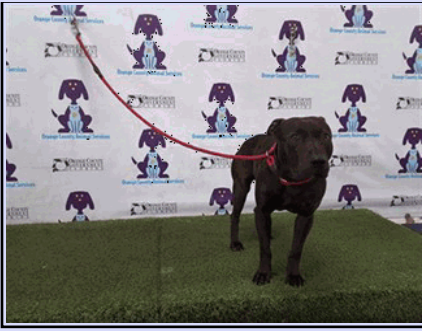

ABC 175 and 181 pulled A590094 for re-assessment. A590094 allowed leashing easily and walked nicely on leash. In the yard, A590094 sought social with both handlers and allowed full handling. A590094 was affectionate in yard. A female staff member walked by the yard and A590094 became very vocal and reactive (barking with whale eye and retreating).

Response seemed to be fear reactivity. A590094 allowed handlers to grab leash and went back to loose/wiggly.

Recommendation: Boost to foster, rescue, and/or social due to new reactivity; may be declining behaviorally/mentally.

In the yard, A590094 did the zoomies and was very high energy. A590094 was intermittently inappropriate with energy level, as he would height-seek and jump on handler. A590094 took verbal correction well and was able to calm down when treats were used or when 175 gave him a toy. A590094 was very affectionate intermittently as well, climbing into handlers' lap and allowing full handling. After about 5-10 minutes of getting his energy out, A590094 laid down and chewed on one of the bones in the yard. No issues observed; able to place back into kennel easily.

In the yard, A590094 was timid but sought social/comfort in both handlers, climbing in their laps. A590094 allowed full handling without issue. 181 brought out a spayed female, A590450. A590094 greeted A590450 with exuberant and loose/wiggly body language, play bowing and pawing at the fence. 181 came into the yard. A590094 became very intrusive and over threshold, startling the other dog who was climbing on 181. Did not proceed with pairing attempt.  
Recommendation: Due to two prior K33s and conflicting body language, recommend Single Dog Only.

After dog test handlers kept A590094 out in the yard where he was avoidant for the majority of outing, only approaching 181 in attempt to mount but listend when verberally corrected. Moving to advanced for this reason.

We tried to get him to sniff the back area first. When he got near her again he tried to bite twice. We took both dogs out of the yard. When bringing A592868 back inside he was barking at kennels. I was able to get the leash off without issues.

ABC 175 pulled A592868 for re-assessment, as A592868 has been showing slight mental/behavioral decline--escalated frustration in the kennel and new reactivity towards other dogs (as he had been previously an easily paired dog). A592868 allowed leashing easily and pulled slightly. In the yard, A592868 explored independently but would seek social with 175 intermittently. A592868 allowed full handling, but did have a more-so solemn/depressed demeanor. A592868 did rush the fence when another dog came by, but was easily recalled and then sat at handlers feet. No issues handling in yard. Recommendation: Place on Project Pets. Boost out to rescue, foster, and/or social due to observed mental/behavioral decline.

A592868's e-collar wasn't on properly, so 175 took it off and placed it back on. A592868 was a bit timid about that but allowed placing it back on with a treat lure. A592868 takes treats very roughly; recommend tossing treats. No issues handling or placing back into kennel.

Once in the yard, A592868 started aloof and stiff but loosened after a few minutes and allowed 180 to pet and fully handle him. 180 brought out a spayed female dog (A387719). A592868 showed little to no interest for the first several minutes of the interaction. After that, A592868 approached the female to sniff but then retreated again. Handlers moved the interaction to the kennel and dogs ignored each other. Left paired.

A592868 pulled slightly but did not display any reactivity in the hallway. In the yard, A592868 was timid, but sought social and comfort in 175. A592868 would lean into 175 and put head in 175's lap. A592868 allowed full handling without issue. No issues observed in yard; remained timid but remained allowing handling. Recommendation: Placing on for reassess to ensure A592868 can be leashed and handled by others. Attempt pairing +/- move to general.

ABC 175 and 181 pulled A592868 for assessment. A592868 displayed fear reactivity in the kennel, tail tucking and retreating to the back. When 175 attempted to leash, A592868 would tail tuck, whale eye, and vocalize. 175 was able to gently and slowly leash A592868, who then began wagging tail. A592868 walked nicely past the other dogs and walked well on leash. Once outside, ASO 242 stated she observed some concerning behavior from A592868 during feeding time. 242 stated that A592868 would charge up at her when she took away the empty food bowl. Handlers took A592868 to the yard. In the yard, A592868 displayed heavy conflict. A592868 would seek social and comfort, leaning into handler. A592868 would allow handling, but would occasionally stiffen and whale eye. Warning signals were very subtle and difficult to decipher trigger. 175 brought some wet food out to test for resource guarding. While 175 was knelt down and placing food into the bowl, A592868 was stiff and hard staring. 175 slid the food over and A592868 began gulping the food. 175 used the fake hand and A592868 began gulping faster with stiff body language and tail tuck. A592868 did not attempt to bite at the hand. After that, handlers stayed in the yard with A592868. A592868 would intermittently seek social with both handlers, but did remain leery and timid.

Recommendation: Continue working on socialization and continue monitoring kennel reactivity for improvement or decline.
